

PPE Notice

Beginning February 1, 2016 Linden Lumber, LLC will require all person passing the property gates to wear safety toed boots, safety glasses and hard hats. Hearing protection is required to be on your person as well so that you may wear it as necessary for noise.

Please note that safety toed boots have ankle protection and extends above the ankle, such as the example below. They should be ASTM F-2413 or ANSI Z41 approved as sewn on the tongue of most boots.

Safety glasses must be ANSI Z87 approved. This will be imprinted somewhere on the glasses themselves, usually on the rim. Any variation of Z87 is acceptable. Please understand that shades are not allowed indoors.

Hard hats should be ANSI Z89.1 approved. Bump caps are not acceptable. Be aware that hard hats should be inspected prior to usage and should be replaced around 5 years.

Hearing protection isn't required to be worn when entering the gate, but should be on your being so that's it is available when needed. Disposable hearing protection is provided so please replace as necessary to keep clean.

Safety glasses, hard hats and hearing protection is provided free of charge to Linden Lumber employees and may be replaced free of charge when they do not pass prior use inspection. However, it is your responsibility to maintain, store and be accountable for your PPE. Therefore, if you intentionally damage or do not bring your PPE to work then you will be charged for the replacement.

Also note that your PPE must continue to be worn during breaks and lunches unless you are in the lunch room or administrative office buildings.
